Databuild THEN

- Humble beginnings as a lead tracker in the garage of Peter and Matilda Burger
- Initially tracked leads on single residential projects
- Rapidly grew to all building and civil construction projects
- Colour-coded system to identify projects:
 - **Pink:** Planning
 - **Yellow:** Tender
 - **Green:** Awarded
 - **Later, Blue:** Civil projects
- **Bouscan:** Extracts from bills of quantities were read and coded by students at night for distribution the following day
- Distribution evolved from posting information weekly, to daily faxes, and later email
- **Elektrodata** pioneered the electronic offering via stiffy discs, modem downloads, email and finally online (Webleads)

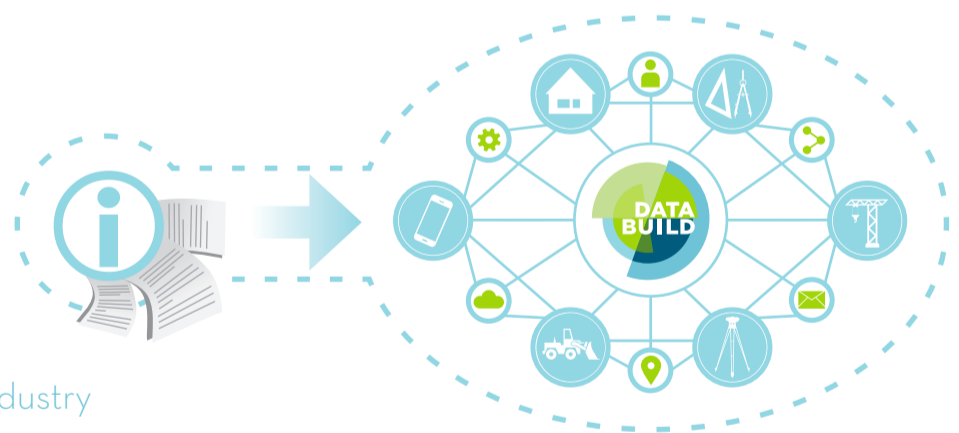
